The account in today's Gospel reading is about a great deal more than the power of Jesus over weather disturbances. The Church Fathers and virtually every commentator since then have seen this storm as standing for many kinds of storms that the Church faces from without and within.

The storm on the lake also stands for the personal storms we might face in our life. We use the image of the storm a great deal, possibly because it is so universal and terrifying an experience.

There are certainly the storms we experience on the outside. But there are also storms on the inside. These are the storms of anxiety, depression & loss. These are really the more dangerous kind of storms. No matter what may be going on in an individual's life, a clear mind and untroubled soul can enable a person to weather any storm. But even when everything round us is going well, turmoil within can make everything we do seem pointless and trivial.

Finally we come to the truth that Christ is with us in the boat. When we are deluged by life, we are tempted to say with the apostles, "Lord, don't you care?" We can understand storms happening to others but not to ourselves. In all our storms, Christ is not simply beside us in our boat but within us

We trust the Christ within us to keep us strong and bring us safely through every storm.
