In today's Gospel for the Thirteenth Sunday, we see that Jesus healed people by touching them or allowing them to touch him. The two miracles cause us to wonder, "Who is this man who can overcome not only disturbances in nature but sickness and death?"
The reading from Wisdom serves as a backdrop to the message that God did not create human beings in order to destroy them, but rather that they should enjoy a blessed immortality. Both the woman with the haemorrhage and the daughter of Jairus were beyond the help of any human power. The woman's and Jairus' great faith is stressed. Both believed that Jesus possessed a supernatural power to heal. The miracles are signs of God's power. The raising of the little girl is a foreshadowing of Jesus' gift of eternal life to all who believe in him. Do you realise that you also have the power to heal?
